The Stage Warriors are women from around the world who use theater to talk about war, abuse, politics, crime, and violence in nations where these subjects too often are taboo. Often abuse of women is used to prevent the entry of women into positions of power in the economy and politics. And, as we now know, the leading edge of reform is often the women of a society. In large measure, the hope of a society for reform and functioning civil society depends on the voices of women and the ability of women to exert their will in the economy, in education, and in politics.

The Stage Warriors have faced stiff resistance. Some have seen their offices consumed in flames. Others have found their cars destroyed. Still others have been physically assaulted. Yet nothing stops these women. They keep their productions together and keep marching out on stage. The interviews in this book explain why they launch drama onto troubled waters, who they help, and the importance of their work. In societies that are, too often, governed by a tired elite with the support of a preferred ethnic group, religious sect, or tribe . . . these women are positioned at the leading edge of reform.

These actresses, directors and writers display the resourcefulness, strength, and promise that characterizes women across the globe who are, very slowly, bringing stability, prosperity, and justice.
