Tragic King is one of those unusual creatures--a second book in series that's as good as the first. The complicated relationship between Severin and Minnow develops further, but now with the added element of Rodrigo, Severin's friend and perhaps business manager, who is also in love with Severin. The three of them form an unsteady triad, with lots of doubt on everyone's part about whether each belongs in the relationship. Things are further complicated by the appearance of Severin's brother, Loic, come from France with the news that their mother (the one who sent Severin to live by himself at the age of 5) has died. Loic moves in and adds to the instability of the triad, even as they plan a wedding ceremony for the 3 of them. The characterization continues to be superb. Severin has developed a few more human traits here and seems more aware at times of the needs of those around him. Minnow continues to be a very sweet masochist sub, and Rodrigo's character develops into a strong third in the relationship. My only real complaint is at the end. (view spoiler) There's a fair amount of disturbing content, pretty much as memories, but for those who like to be forewarned of such things, it's there. All in all, the Duology is superb writing and reading with unique characters and a great story.

This duet was such a pleasant, fun surprise. I had read a lot of positive reviews, but I assumed it would just be hot. Don't get me wrong, it was VERY hot- read the tags, this book wasn't afraid to be unconventional- but it was also heartwarming, emotional, and shockingly sweet. I really loved the characters, even the supporting ones. Really, I would've read more than two books about them and their relationships with one another. Their story was the most cohesive, well-rounded one I've ever read about a romantic relationship comprised of more than two people. Don't get it twisted, though; just because it touches on every aspect of a poly relationship doesn't mean that it's at the expense of good smut. There is definitely plenty of fuck hot sexy times in both books. This story didn't just cross lines, it danced all over them. It had it all- light group sex (mainly just sex in front of other people), mm, menage (mfm, mmf), BDSM... you name it, this story had it. I'm not easily shocked, yet I really thought about drawing diagrams to try to figure out how they managed a few scenes. If you're pervy like me, it's **awesome**.

The first book is mainly compromised of the development of Minnow and Severin's relationship. She takes a job at his secluded manor, basically as his "service human"- a term he actually uses for her. It works, though, because Minnow is quite the masochist, which is helpful, since Severin loves to torture and humiliate her. She halfheartedly tries to fight her attraction to him, but the attempt is feeble at best. However, Sev has serious abandonment issues, as well as painful ghosts in his past (trigger warning for previous abuse). He has little in the way of social skills, but that's okay, because Minnow is patient and kind. Their relationship intensifies and because of his own reasons, he starts to share her with his best friend Rodrigo. They all grow closer... physically and emotionally. In the second book, their relationship becomes polyamorous. The main theme in both books is how Sev tries to slay his demons, and while he sometimes fails, both of his soulmates are there to get him through the worst of it. Basically, he learns how to love and trust... well, and fuck, since he wasn't doing that before Minnow came along (and then later, when Rodrigo joins the fun).

“So is he developmentally delayed?”

“No. He’s just a dick.”

Severin, AKA Master, was a very complicated character. It became quickly clear that deep down, he's a good person, so that made me cheer for him. Still, that doesn't mean I didn't get annoyed of him at times. I felt awful for what he had been through, and I didn't necessarily blame him for his hang-ups, but Minnow and Rodrigo were far more understanding than I probably would've been. I damn near got whiplash from his constant mood swings. I'm guessing they put up with him because for a hermit, he was an expert in the sack. The man's a sex demon in every single way. He ran the show, and the show was scorching hot. His personal growth by the end was rewarding, but yeah- he shines between the sheets.

She was fucked. He was so broken, but she was already his.

I'm just going to put this out there: I. Loved. Minnow.

It would be easy to call her a doormat- she's so unbelievably, inherently submissive- but that's just not true. Yes, she was patient and tolerant, but she has this massive heart that made me feel a kinship to her in the first few chapters. It takes a special woman to love Severin, and it takes a huge heart to love two dominant men unconditionally. It was believable that Minnow could be this woman. Yes, she went from zero to horny in the blink of an eye. Sure, there were a few times I wanted her to safeword Sev for being an emotionally closed-off dick. I'm so glad she didn't then, though, because when she finally did draw the line in the sand, it hit both Sev and the reader that much harder. Minnow may have been the submissive, but she was the glue that stuck the three of them together, and she was strong enough to do the job well.

“Everyone needs people to take care of them sometimes, no matter how grown up they are, preciosa. When loving him hurts, I’ll be around to kiss it better.”

Oh, Rodrigo. If anyone else had thrust themselves in Minnow and Sev's relationship, I would've disliked them, but it was impossible not to love Ro, the switch of the triad. His unconditional love for Sev, and eventually Minnow too, was actually quite touching. He submits only to Sev, and I like to think that's because he loves him so much that he wants to be what he needs, even if he's always been a dominant (and still is to Min). I loved how understanding and tolerant Ro could be, but also how he wasn't afraid to be protective and territorial. Like I said, nobody else could've been the right fit for Minnow and Severin. He filled all the empty spaces they couldn't reach. He struggles with feeling like the third wheel, and for a while, it's justified, but by the end, there are no more doubts. His fearless love and devotion finally gets rewarded, and I was so there for it.

“Oh, but I’m into your pain. I love that she enjoys being hurt, and I love that you don’t. It’s the best of both worlds.”

The only negatives? Sometimes, the story seemed a bit long. I think a few parts could've been condensed, namely some of Sev's emotional problems. I understood them, but after awhile, they became emotionally taxing. Thankfully, when I felt that way, there was usually a distracting, extremely hot sex scene just around the corner, so that helped. Which leads me to my next point- Sparrow Beckett is a unicorn. Rarely have I read books this hot that have such emotional depth. I will definitely seek out more from this duo in the future. **If you are in the mood for a surprisingly emotionally rewarding story with some of the best kinky sex scenes out there, then don't miss out on these two books!
